

Web site launched for groundwater program

Eastern San Joaquin County landowners, including those from parts of Victor, Lockeford and Morada, can evaluate whether their property is suitable for inclusion in the Farmington Groundwater Recharge Program by visiting a new Web site launched by the Stockton East Water District and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

The groundwater program is a \$33.5 million effort to help restore the depleting water table and increasing saltwater intrusion into the water table. Under the program, Stockton East will rotate water with other land uses through short- and long-term agreements with landowners.
